1. Abstracts must be submitted electronically.
2. Submission deadline is 1st May 2010.
3. All abstracts must be written in English.
4. Abstracts topics should be related to renal patient education.
5. No abbreviations to be used in the title.
6. Titles should be no longer than 14 words.
7. Poster presentations carry the same status as oral presentations.
8. Accepted abstracts will be published in Abstract Book.
9. The following subdivisions are recommended:
 - **Background**
 - **Objectives**
 - **Methods**
 - **Results**
 - **Conclusion/Application to practice**
10. Abstracts should be on a single side of A4, using Ariel font size 11, with a 1cm margin. Longer abstract will not be accepted.
11. All abstract authors will be notified by e-mail, by the 21st May.
